## **DECISION ON THE PAPERS**

This is an application for a temporary authority to carry on the sale and supply of alcohol under an existing on-licence with an expiry date of 31 October 2022.

The reason for the temporary authority is due to the business changing ownership. The takeover date is 17 May 2021.

The applicant will be the new owner of the business. Blueline Hospitality Limited has two directors, Harpreet Bhuller and Rajbrinder Singh. They are also the directors of another two companies. Bhuller has worked at the Clendon Inn Bar at Manurewa. Both Directors hold the LCQ and will be applying for Managers Certificates in the near future. Both the directors intend to be hands on in the day to day running of the premises.

No matters in opposition to this temporary authority have been raised by the Inspector or by the Police.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard and we grant the applicant a temporary authority to carry on the sale and supply of alcohol under the existing licence.

Section 136(4) of the Act requires the Committee, on making an order, to impose any conditions that the Act requires an on or off-licence to be issued subject to, may impose any conditions that the Act enables the licence to be issued subject to and may impose any other reasonable conditions it thinks fit. Sections 112, 116 and 117 of the Act detail compulsory and discretionary conditions of the licence in force.

The temporary authority is subject to the following conditions in addition to the existing conditions of the licence in force:

- a) It is a condition of this Temporary Authority that the holder must comply with all the conditions of the current on-licence, and the provisions of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
- b) That an application for an on-licence be made within two months of the date of issue.
- c) The temporary authority must be displayed next to the base licence attached to the interior of the premises so as to be easily read by persons entering through the principal entrance.

The applicant's attention is drawn to s.136(5) of the Act which states that the person authorised by this order has the same duties, obligations, and liabilities, as the holder of the underlying on-licence concerned.

The certificate can be issued immediately.
