DECISION ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a second temporary authority to carry on the sale and supply of alcohol under an existing with an expiry date of 9 December 2022. The first temporary authority will expire 19 January 2022.

The applicant has submitted a substantive application; unfortunately, the MOH have not yet submitted a report. Due to the Christmas shut down period Council and the applicant, believe the MOH report will not be received in time to allow the substantive application to be completed.

This is the reason for this second application. There are no other changes

The applicant has purchased The Bottle-O Te Aroha, they took over on 8 November 2021

There are two directors of PB Liquor Limited. Jatinder Singh and Gultajvir Kaur, therefore for all intents and purposes they are the owner of the premises.

No matters in opposition to this temporary authority have been raised by the Inspector or by the Police.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard and we grant the applicant a temporary authority to carry on the sale and supply of alcohol under the existing licence.

Section 136(4) of the Act requires the Committee, on making an order, to impose any conditions that the Act requires an on or off-licence to be issued subject to, may impose any conditions that the Act enables the licence to be issued subject to and may impose any other reasonable conditions it thinks fit. Sections 112, 116 and 117 of the Act detail compulsory and discretionary conditions of the licence in force.

The temporary authority is subject to the following conditions in addition to the existing conditions of the licence in force:

- a) It is a condition of this Temporary Authority that the holder must comply with all the conditions of the current off-licence, and the provisions of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
- b) The temporary authority must be displayed next to the base licence attached to the interior of the premises so as to be easily read by persons entering through the principal entrance.

The applicant's attention is drawn to s.136(5) of the Act which states that the person authorised by this order has the same duties, obligations, and liabilities, as the holder of the underlying off-licence concerned.

The certificate can be issued immediately.
