DECISION ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a temporary authority to carry on the sale and supply of alcohol under an existing off-licence with an expiry date of 4 April 2026.

The reason for the temporary authority is due to the business changing ownership. The takeover date is 18 September 2023. The applicant will be the new owner of the business. There is one director of Shelby Trading Limited, Rick Shelby.

Rick Shelby has over 3 years' experience working for Foodstuffs in supermarkets, including holding the role of Duty Manager numerous times in stores with liquor during that time. He also completed his LCQ training and hold a Manager's certificate issued by Auckland City.

No matters in opposition to this temporary authority have been raised by the Inspector or by the Police.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard and we grant the applicant a temporary authority to carry on the sale and supply of alcohol under the existing licence for 3 months.

Section 136(4) of the Act requires the Committee, on making an order, to impose any conditions that the Act requires an on or off-licence to be issued subject to, may impose any conditions that the Act enables the licence to be issued subject to and may impose any other reasonable conditions it thinks fit. Sections 112, 116 and 117 of the Act detail compulsory and discretionary conditions of the licence in force.

The temporary authority is subject to the following conditions in addition to the existing conditions of the licence in force:

- a) It is a condition of this Temporary Authority that the holder must comply with all the conditions of the current off-licence, and the provisions of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
- b) That an application for an off-licence be made within two months of the date of issue.
- c) The temporary authority must be displayed next to the base licence attached to the interior of the premises so as to be easily read by persons entering through the principal entrance.

The applicant's attention is drawn to s.136(5) of the Act which states that the person authorised by this order has the same duties, obligations, and liabilities, as the holder of the underlying off-licence concerned.

The certificate can be issued immediately.
