All dog owners with dogs ordinarily kept in the Matamata Piako district must register with the Matamata Piako District Council.

It is an offence to keep a dog older than three months which is unregistered.

On conviction, a Court may impose a fine up to \$3,000.00.

It is an offence, in making an application for the registration of a dog, to make any written statement knowing the statement to be false. On conviction, a Court may impose a fine of up to \$3,000.00.

If your dog is three months old after 1 August then the fees will be calculated at 1/12th for each complete month remaining in the registration year.

RELEASE OF YOUR INFORMATION

The information kept on this form will be kept by Matamata Piako District Council but may only be used for lawful official purposes and will not be generally available to the public. However, Section 35 of the Dog Control Act 1996 allows the name and address of the owner of any specified dog to be made available to any person who has made a written application for that information. The territorial authority must be satisfied of the identity of that applicant and that the information is required for one of a limited number of specified purposes, such as returning a lost dog to its owner or seeking compensation for damage.

PARTICULARS OF DOG(S)

The Department of Internal Affairs is managing the National Dog Database (NDD), which will hold the information on dogs required by the [Dog Control Act 1996](#).

The National Dog Database is part of the measures introduced in the Act to improve public safety through the use of stronger deterrents, preventative measures, more extensive powers of enforcement, better information about dogs and dog safety education.

As directed by central government District Councils are only able to use approved breed types and colours.

No occupier of a property within an urban area shall keep or permit to be kept on each separate premise more than two dogs of a greater age than three months without obtaining a permit.
