## Reserve classification to meet community needs

Council is proposing to classify approximately 223m<sup>2</sup> of Hētana Street Reserve, Matamata (Lot 2 DPS 86435) as local purpose (community use) reserve. Council intends at the same time to classify the remainder of Lot 2 DPS 86435 as a recreation reserve in accordance with the purpose it was vested.

The proposed classification will allow the Matamata Community Health Shuttle Trust to relocate and extend their existing garage to accommodate for additional fleet. Changing the classification will enable this important community not-for-profit service to operate from a single central facility and the adjoining Matamata Resources Trust (Railside by the Green) to be able to expand its facilities in the future.
