

Public Notice of Summary of Submissions on Proposed Private Plan Change

Clause 7 of Schedule 1 of the Resource Management Act 1991



The Matamata-Piako District Council has prepared a summary of submissions on:

Private Plan Change 51 – Development Concept Plan for Milk Processing Factory Site, Waharoa which seeks to introduce a Development Concept Plan (DCP) for the Open Country Dairy milk processing site in Factory Road, Waharoa.

The purpose of the DCP is to provide for the integrated and coordinated development of the Open Country Dairy site, to allow for additional growth and development of the milk processing facility.

The further submission must be made using Form 6 of Schedule 1 of the Resource Management (Forms, Fees, and Procedure) Regulations 2003 and must be limited to a matter in support of or in opposition to an original submission to the plan change. Copies of this form are available from the locations listed above (i.e. any Council office or library, or on the Council website). You must also send a copy of your submission to the original submitter within five working days of lodging your submission with Council.

Further submissions close at 5.00pm on Wednesday 13th December 2017, being no later than 10 working days after the day on which this public notice is given.
