Notification of Road Reconstruction Works SH24 (Mangawhero Road), Matamata Start Date: Monday 14th January 2019

As part of the New Zealand Transport Agency's ongoing commitment to maintaining the State Highway network, road reconstruction works are to be undertaken by Higgins Contractors on State Highway 24 in Matamata between Kilbride Road and Waihou Street (refer to the Site Plan on page 2 of this letter).

What's happening on SH24 and when?

To keep this road safe for everyone who uses it, we'll be rebuilding the pavement and constructing a new road surface.

The proposed start date is Monday 14th January 2019 and the works are expected to take up to four weeks to complete.

How will this work affect me?

We always aim to do our work with as little disruption as possible; however we also know that road works can cause inconvenience for people living near them or travelling through the site.

Construction works will take place on-site between the hours of 6.00am and 7.00pm.

The nature of the works means that one lane will be completely closed at a time while the reconstruction works are underway. Traffic management will be in operation to control the flow of traffic on the active lane.

Access to properties within the work site will be discussed directly with affected owners/occupiers prior to the start of the works. Alternative parking will be available within the new residential development opposite Kilbride Road and accessed from SH24.
